AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING AS AMENDED ZONING MAP ENTITLED "ZONING MAP, CITIES OF BARDSTOWN, BLOOMFIELD, FAIRFIELD, NEW HAVEN AND NELSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY"

BY CHANGING THE DISTRICT CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY LOCATED IN NELSON COUNTY AS HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED FROM B-3, REGIONAL RETAIL BUSINESS DISTRICT TO BE REZONED AS R-3, MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Joint City-County Planning Commission of Nelson County, Kentucky, on November 9, 2010 held a public hearing under the provisions of KRS Chapter 100, and after careful consideration, the Commission on November 23, 2010, voted to approve and recommend the amendment to the Fiscal Court of Nelson County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF NELSON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:

SECTION I: Boundaries of the district as shown on district map entitled "ZONING MAP, CITIES OF BARDSTOWN, BLOOMFIELD, FAIRFIELD, NEW HAVEN AND NELSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY" be and the same are hereby amended for reasons adopted and stated in the recommendation of the Joint City-County Planning Commission all of which is made a part hereof as if fully set out herein, including the letter of recommendation dated November 30, 2010, from the said Joint City-County Planning Commission of Nelson County to the Nelson County Fiscal Court, so that the following described property of Daniel Blincoe (Applicant/Owner) and Joseph L. Hutchins (Co-Applicant/Developer) is presently B-3, Regional

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Retail Business District be and the same is placed as R-3, Multi-Family Residential District and said property is described as follows:

Being Lots #11 and 12 in Phase Three of the Maywood Commercial Development as shown on Plat of record in Plat Cabinet 5, Slot 162, in the Nelson County Clerk's office containing 1.23 acres.

SECTION II: This Ordinance becomes effective immediately upon passage by the Fiscal Court of Nelson County.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall be published in the Kentucky Standard newspaper by title and summary within 30 days after adoption.

SECTION IV: This Order or parts of Orders in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

AMENDED PERSONNEL POLICY

Sam Hutchins moved to amend the cell phone policy as it was presented in ordinance form on Dec. 21, 2010 (Book 35, Page 131) for first reading; amendmend would state that "each department may implement a stricter cell phone policy to fit department needs. . .shall not exceed ordinance standards." Following discussion in which it was decided that the ordinance would be rewritten and resubmitted for first reading, Magistrate Hutchins withdrew his motion.

BUILDING INSPECTION PROGRAM DISCUSSED

As requested, and for better understanding of the county's building inspection program, magistrates were presented with budget reports for the past three years. Note was made that Joe Cambron's salary presently is paid entirely from the code inspection office; he has many unrelated duties that should be funded through the General Fund. Magistrates were also given a report on numbers related to pre-built storage buildings that were permitted last year. A third report showed a breakdown on types of permits—whether residential or commercial, showing what is permitted within the City of Bardstown and what is outside the corporate limites. Court members were given the following estimate of fees associated with building a 1,500 sq. ft. home:

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RE: Inspection fees and costs for a new home

Keith asked about the total cost of fees and inspections for a new home. As a model, I used a 1500 square foot home with a septic system. If city sewer is used, septic costs would be replaced by sewer tap fees.

**LANDFILL/SOLID WASTE

Brad Spalding reported on day-to-day business at the landfill, back to normal following holidays. He explained mechanical problems being experienced with the truck used for dead-animal retrieval, with need to consider a truck during budgeting. He also described clutch failure on a roll-off truck; repair will be done in-house.

Spalding discussed with Court members a State guideline for composting of animal carcasses, but explained that the time period involved often makes this impractical for the volume handled at the landfill. This is a method of disposal that is encouraged for on-the-farm use.

Application has been made for a \$3,000 annual grant to help offset the cost of tire disposal by the landfill.

(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of KRS 67.710(7), the county judge/executive of any county may appoint a deputy county judge/executive, and a reasonable number of other assistants, secretaries, and clerical workers within the office of the county judge/executive as determined by the fiscal court, who shall serve at his pleasure. The fiscal court, pursuant to KRS 64.550(4), shall fix reasonable compensation for the deputy county judge/executive and such other employees.

(2) The deputy county judge/executive may exercise all administrative powers, duties, and responsibilities of that office, and may assume such other responsibilities as shall be prescribed in the administrative code of the county, except that the deputy county judge/executive shall not act for the county judge/executive as a member or presiding officer of the fiscal court.
