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PLANNING AND ZONING – REZONING ORDINANCE (SECOND READING)

#2357 Marie Barnes Hubbard Trust. . .HC Holdings, LLC

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING AS AMENDED ZONING MAP ENTITLED “ZONING MAP, CITIES OF BARDSTOWN, BLOOMFIELD, FAIRFIELD, NEW HAVEN AND NELSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY”

BY CHANGING THE DISTRICT CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY LOCATED IN NELSON COUNTY AS HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED FROM A-1, AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO BE REZONED AS B-3, REGIONAL RETAIL BUSINESS DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Joint City-County Planning Commission of Nelson County, Kentucky, on July 12, 2011 held a public hearing under the provisions of KRS Chapter 100, and after careful consideration, the Commission on July 26, 2011, voted to approve and recommend the amendment to the Fiscal Court of Nelson County.

WHEREAS, the Court held a first reading on August 23, 2011 and after due advertisement held a second reading and adoption on September 6, 2011, 2011, and after due consideration,

UPON MOTION OF Jeff Lear, SECONDED BY Keith Metcalfe, AND A VOTE BEING HAD AND THE COUNTY JUDGE ANNOUNCING THAT THE MOTION CARRIED,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF NELSON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1: Boundaries of the district as shown on district map entitled “ZONING MAP, CITIES OF BARDSTOWN, BLOOMFIELD, FAIRFIELD, NEW HAVEN AND NELSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY” be and the same are hereby amended for reasons adopted and stated in the recommendation of the Joint City-County Planning Commission all of which is made a part hereof as if fully set out herein, including the letter of recommendation dated July 28, 2011, from the said Joint City-County Planning Commission of Nelson County to the Nelson County Fiscal Court, so that the following described property of Marie Barnes Hubbard Trust – John Douglas Hubbard, Trustee (Applicant/Owner) and Rayfield Houghlin & Susan D. Clark (HC Holdings, LLC) (Co-Applicants/Buyers), is presently A-1, Agricultural District be and the same is placed as B-3, Regional Retail Business District and said property is described as follows:

The Point of Reference is the common corner between Barnes, et al and Monin, on the r/w line of KY Hwy 245; thence N 50-04-47 W 722.66 ft. to a ½” iron pin (set) "HIBBS 2981", in the r/w line of KY Hwy 245, the Point of Beginning; thence leaving the road with a division across Barnes, et al S 32-58-24 W 459.31 ft. to a W' iron pin (set) "HIBBS 2981"; thence N 52-07-47 W 208.53 ft. to a ½” iron pin (set) "HIBBS 2981"; thence N 02-46-08 E 184.78 ft. to a ½” iron pin (set) "HIBBS 2981"; thence N 32-58-24 E 300.00 ft. to a ½” iron pin (set) "HIBBS 2981", corner to Barnes, et al, in the r/w line of KY Hwy 245; thence with said r/w line S 57-01-36 E 103.17 ft. to a ½” iron pin (set) "HIBBS 2981"; thence S 51-46-06E 198.40 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 3.00 acres

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SECTION II: The above rezoning is subject to the following binding elements:

- a. The owner shall provide a frontage/backage road and/or shared access for and connectivity to adjoining properties be planned and provided.
- b. The subject property must be served by public sanitary sewer.


SECTION III: This Ordinance becomes effective immediately upon passage by the Fiscal Court of Nelson County.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall be published in the Kentucky Standard newspaper by title and summary within 30 days after adoption.


SECTION V: This Order or parts of Orders in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

ORDINANCE RELATING TO PROPERTY TAX RATES FOR 2011-12 (SECOND READING)

The following ordinance is approved after a second reading on motion of Sam Hutchins, second of Keith Metcalfe, and by affirmative vote of all Court members:

ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SETTING OF PROPERTY TAX RATES TO FUND THE 2011-2012 BUDGET OF THE COUNTY OF NELSON

WHEREAS the County adopted a budget for the 2011-12 fiscal year on June 7, 2011; and

WHEREAS property tax rates to fund the said budget could not be adopted prior to the County's receipt of the State Local Finance Officer's Certification of the Maximum Permissible Revenue from ad valorem taxes in accordance with KRS 68.245, which was received July 21, 2011; and

WHEREAS the said certification establishes compensating and maximum tax rates for the County;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF NELSON, KENTUCKY:

SECTION ONE: There is levied for the year 2011 the ad valorem tax rates per \$100.00 assessed valuation on all taxable property with the County for General Fund as indicated:

ORDINANCE - REAPPORTIONMENT (FIRST READING)

County Judge-Executive Dean Watts presented in open Court for first reading the following proposed ordinance related to reapportionment of magisterial boundaries in Nelson County, KY.

Said proposed ordinance was read in open Court in resume form and a full copy of the proposed ordinance is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE REAPPORTIONMENT AND BOUNDARY RELOCATION OF MAGISTERIAL DISTRICTS 1, 2, 3, 4 AND 5 OF NELSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, KRS 67.045 adopted by the 1982 Kentucky legislature directs all counties to reapportion their magisterial districts, and in conformity thereto, the Nelson County Fiscal Court hereby publishes its' intention to reapportion, and

WHEREAS, in conformity with the above statute, the Nelson County Fiscal Court, by its order entered on May 18, 2011 and became effective May 31, 2011 appointed Thomas A. Hart, 2186 Woodlawn Road, Bardstown, Kentucky 40004, Kenneth R. Catlett, 114 West Wind Trail, Bardstown, Kentucky 40004 and Robert D. (Bobby) Settles, 678 Ben Irvin Road, Bardstown, Kentucky 40004 as members of the reapportionment committee to reapportion the magisterial districts for Nelson County, Kentucky.

That reapportionment committee met on June 20, 2011 and July 20, 2011, with all members being present.

That the reapportionment committee at their meetings proposed and recommended to the Nelson County Fiscal Court a planned reapportionment for each respective magisterial district.

At its meeting of September 6, 2011, the Nelson County Fiscal Court received the committee's recommendations and made modification and thereupon proposed the adoption of

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the reapportionment plan as follows:

THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF NELSON STATE OF KENTUCKY, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS

SECTION 1. That pursuant to provisions of KRS 67.045 and in conformity thereto, the Nelson County Fiscal Court hereby establishes the following as boundaries for each of the magisterial districts:

Magisterial District #1 – See Exhibit A
Magisterial District #2 – See Exhibit B
Magisterial District #3 – See Exhibit C
Magisterial District #4 – See Exhibit D
Magisterial District #5 – See Exhibit E

SECTION 2. That in addition to the boundaries established pursuant to Section 1 of this Ordinance, and in order to clarify the same, the Nelson County Fiscal Court hereby adopts the County map which is annexed hereto and made a part hereof by reference, and for identification are marked Exhibit 1, constituting general overlays of the entire area of Nelson County and Bardstown with the magisterial boundary lines set forth thereon;

SECTION 3. Where any part or portion of any boundary line cannot be established, the same shall be determined by the description and by the map, and where either is at variance with the other, the maps filed herewith as Exhibit 1 shall be given first preference.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances, resolutions, orders and parts thereof in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict and this Ordinance, order and resolution shall take effect and be in force upon publication as required by law.

EXHIBIT A

District 1

Beginning at a point on the Nelson/LaRue County line where the Rolling Fork is crossed by a Census line L4020, power line (Kentucky Utilities). Approximately 0.63 miles to the southwest of KY 52 (Nelsonville Rd).


