RURAL SECONDARY ROAD PROGRAM

Patty Dunaway and Kentucky Transportation Cabinet personnel appeared before Nelson Fiscal Court to explain the State's Rural Secondary Road Program and to present recommendations for use of this year's allocation, as follows:

### RURAL SECONDARY PROGRAM

The program is funded by 22.2% of the Motor Fuel Tax receipts.

These funds are allocated to all 120 counties based on a five point formula.

***Five Point Formula***

- 1/5 Equally among all counties
- 1/5 Based on rural population
- 1/5 Based on road miles
- 2/5 Based on land area

Money allocated to a county is not transferable to another county.

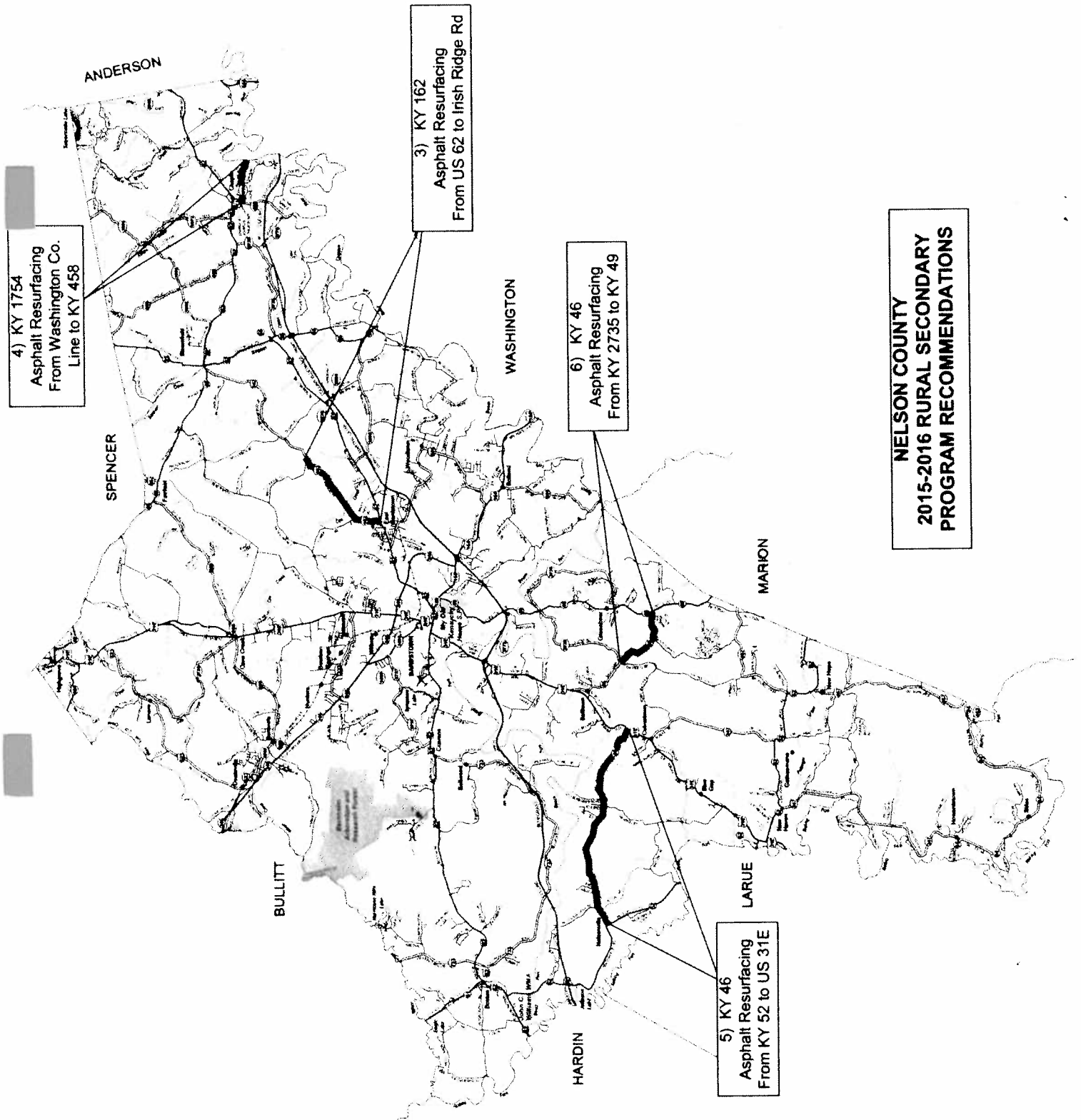

On recommendation of Judge Watts, and on motion of Jerry Hahn, second of Keith Metcalfe, and by affirmative vote of all Court members, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED to approve the State's recommendations as presented, with Judge Watts pointing out that Fiscal Court has the option of pulling out about \$150,000 of these funds for use on County roads; he told State officials that he wants to keep this option open if there are cuts to other road programs as a result of current gas tax issues.

PRIMARY ROADS - Dunaway told members of Nelson Fiscal Court that higher volume roads that have been approved for work are US 150 beginning at US 62 to KY 245 (1.7 mi.) and a section of KY 52 from US 62 to the Larue County line. Also noted was work that will be done on KY 49 near Heaven Hill.

31-E - Information regarding progress on the 31-E project was given; project was let in January but State is waiting on environmental permits. Gas tax issues may impact this project. Paved shoulders have been requested on

Dear County Judge-Executive:

In accordance with the provisions of KRS 64.5275, the Department for Local Government has calculated the annual compensation which shall be paid to **County Judge-Executives, County Clerks, Sheriffs and Jailers** for the 2015 calendar year.

The compensation for the above named officers is determined by a salary schedule containing nine levels corresponding to nine population groups and four salary steps for each population group. After a cost of living adjustment for 2015, the maximum salary for any official for calendar year 2015 is \$118,217.31; the minimum is \$65,019.52.

The actual salary for any individual officer named above depends on (1) the population of the county in which he/she serve and (2) the number of years of experience, as certified to DLG. This information has been compiled on the attached schedule entitled: "*Maximum Salary Authorizations - 2015: County Judge Executive*" to display the 2015 authorized salary for the office of County Judge-Executive in each of Kentucky's counties.
