## 2016 PROPERTY TAX RATE ORDINANCE (SECOND READING)

The following ordinance is approved after a second reading on motion of Jeff Lear, second of Jerry Hahn, and by affirmative vote of all Court members:

### ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SETTING OF PROPERTY TAX RATES TO FUND THE 2016-2017 BUDGET OF THE COUNTY OF NELSON

WHEREAS the County adopted a budget for the 2016-2017 fiscal year on May 17, 2016; and

WHEREAS property tax rates to fund the said budget could not be adopted prior to the County's receipt of the State Local Finance Officer's Certification of the Maximum Permissible Revenue from ad valorem taxes in accordance with KRS 68.245, which was received July 14, 2016; and

WHEREAS the said certification establishes compensating and maximum tax rates for the County;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF NELSON, KENTUCKY:

SECTION ONE: There is levied for the year 2016 the ad valorem tax rates per \$100.00 assessed valuation on all taxable property with the County for General Fund as indicated:

SECTION TWO: The said revenues shall be expended in accordance with the provisions of the budget adopted by the Fiscal Court of the County of Nelson on May 17, 2016.


SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be published in The Kentucky Standard newspaper by title and summary within 30 days after adoption.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance becomes effective immediately upon passage and publication.

## WORLD WAR II MEMORIAL

Judge Watts described a World War II memorial that has been designed for installation on the east side of the Old Courthouse, commemorating and naming those from Nelson County who sacrificed their lives during the Second World War. Names were gathered with the help of Dr. Harry Spalding, American Legion Post 121, and research through The Kentucky Standard; space has been left for additions if other names are discovered. Description was given to Court members: American Legion will contribute to cover cost. On motion of Bernard Ice, second of Jeff Lear, by unanimous vote of the Court, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED to authorize Judge Watts to order the monument from Kentucky Monuments at \$12,000.
