

REZONING REQUEST - NO ACTION

Following rezoning request was reviewed by members of Nelson Fiscal Court; however, Court took no action:

RE: Zoning Map Amendment #2473
Sheila Evans
A-1 (Agriculture District) to R-1A (Single Family Residential District)

Dear Judge Watts and Fiscal Court Members:

On the night of September 27, 2016 the Joint City-County Planning Commission of Nelson County held a public hearing and meeting on the application of Sheila Evans to rezone 0.689 acres on the south side of New Shepherdsville Road (KY 245), approximately 330 feet west of Antlers Trace and approximately 0.232 mile east of Old Henpeck Road (Proposed Tract #1A, Sheila Evans) from A-1 (Agriculture District) to R-1A (Single Family Residential District).

After the public hearing, the Planning Commission reviewed and discussed the testimony and evidence. Ms. Brady made the following motion:

"I'll make a motion to recommend approval of zoning map amendment, application #2473, agenda #479 based on the testimony and evidence as presented at the public hearing. Based on that testimony and evidence, I make the following findings of fact that the zoning map amendment is in agreement with the adopted Comprehensive Plan, that the subject property fronts on New Shepherdsville Road, that the proposed lot will be served by a new entrance and prior to any permit for a new dwelling on the proposed lot, an entrance permit must be obtained from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for any new entrance off of KY 245, that the subject property is located within the Deatsville Village Traditional Residential Neighborhood, and that the requested R-1A zoning and proposed single-family residential use are consistent with the Village acceptable densities, illustrative land uses, and development and public service policies. These findings of fact and recommendation include as an exhibit the Applicant's file which I have reviewed prior to making this motion."

Mr. Carpenter seconded the motion. The motion carried 9-0.



The Planning Commission's recommendation relating to the proposed amendment shall become final and the map amendment shall be automatically implemented subject to the provisions of KRS 100.347, all as set forth in the planning commission recommendations, unless within twenty-one (21) days after the final action by the planning commission : (a) Any aggrieved person files a written request with the planning commission that the final decision shall be made by the appropriate legislative body or fiscal court; or (b) The appropriate legislative body or fiscal files a notice with the planning commission that the legislative body or fiscal court shall decide the map amendment.

If the legislative body or fiscal court elects to decide the zoning map amendment, the enclosed "Notice/Request for Legislative Body to Decide Zoning Map Amendment" must be submitted to the Planning Commission within 21 days from the date of the Planning Commission's final action. The legislative body of fiscal court must take final action upon the zoning map amendment within ninety (90) days of the date upon which the planning commission takes its final action.

Also enclosed are copies of the map amendment record (application, exhibits, review) and unapproved (draft) summary minutes.
