Following discussion, during which County Engineer Brad Spalding told Court members that contractors are State certified and must be bonded, on his recommendation, and on motion of Bernard Ice, second of Keith Metcalfe, by unanimous vote of the Court, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED to award the contract for Hugh Ice Loop bridge replacement to Scott & Murphy and the contract for Higdon Loop bridge replacement to Galusha Contracting. Funding is through an 80/20 grant; Spalding noted that there will be change orders for items that the county must provide.

-BLACKTOP - Court members were told of numerous blacktop projects underway throughout the County, although Magistrates' blacktop projects are on hold until Mago catches up State and other jobs. Also noted was anticipated State letting of HWY 150 bridge on Oct. 27 (bridge over BG Pkwy).




