RESOLUTION OF THE FISCAL COURT OF NELSON COUNTY, REQUESTING THAT THE KENTUCKY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AUTHORITY ADOPT A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF REVENUE BONDS IN AN AMOUNT OF UP TO \$135,000,000, THE PROCEEDS OF WHICH WILL PROVIDE FOR THE FINANCING OF CERTAIN OUTSTANDING BONDS THAT FINANCED AND/OR REFINANCED KENTUCKYONE HEALTH PROJECTS IN NELSON COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the Kentucky Economic Development Finance Authority (the "Authority") is authorized to issue bonds from time to time under the provisions of Sections 154.10-035(2), 154.20-035(1) and 103.200 through 103.285 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes (the "Act") and to use the proceeds of such bonds to make loans to provide financing or refinancing the costs of acquiring, constructing and installing a "health care facility" within the meaning of the Act;

WHEREAS, the Authority has previously issued bonds for the benefit of Catholic Health Initiatives, a Colorado nonprofit corporation ("CHI") determined by the Internal Revenue Service to be a charitable organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Effective February 1, 2019, CHI and Dignity Health, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation ("Dignity Health") aligned their respective ministries as a single, Catholic, nonprofit health system known as CommonSpirit Health (the "System");

WHEREAS, KentuckyOne Health, Inc., a Kentucky corporation, is a wholly-owned entity within the System and the sole corporate member of Flaget Healthcare, Inc., which owns and operates Flaget Memorial Hospital (the "Hospital"), located in the geographic territory of Nelson County (the "County");

WHEREAS, the System has requested that the Authority issue its industrial building revenue bonds (the "Bonds") pursuant to the Act, in an amount not to exceed \$135,000,000, to loan the proceeds thereof to one or more System Affiliates identified on Exhibit A hereto (collectively, the "Borrower") to: (i) (x) refinance all or a portion of the Authority's Revenue Bonds (Catholic Health Initiatives) Series 2009A (the "2009A Bonds"), and/or (y) acquisition finance all or a portion of projects financed and/or refinanced by the Authority's Revenue Bonds (Catholic Health Initiatives) Series 2013A (the "2013A Bonds" and collectively with the 2009A Bonds, the "Existing Bonds"), (ii) pay costs of issuance and (iii) fund a debt service reserve fund for the Bonds, if the System determines it is necessary and desirable. The proceeds of the Existing Bonds were used to pay or reimburse certain System Affiliates for, or and improvements to and equipment at the Hospital and at other health care and health related facilities owned and/or operated by certain System Affiliates and located in or near Lexington, Bardstown, London, Mt. Sterling, and Nicholasville (collectively, the "Projects") and to refinance certain commercial paper notes the proceeds of which were used to finance a portion of the Projects;

WHEREAS, the Authority and certain System Affiliates will enter into a loan agreement pursuant to which such System Affiliates will make loan payments to the Authority sufficient to pay all of the principal of, premium, if any, and interest on the Bonds as the same become due;

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Fiscal Court of Nelson County, the refinancing of the Projects will tend to accomplish the public purposes of the Act by promoting the economic development of the Commonwealth, relieving conditions of unemployment, preserving existing jobs and encouraging the increase of industry therein;

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable and in the best interests of the County that the Bonds be approved and issued by the Authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF NELSON COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The County, through its Fiscal Court, does hereby request that the Authority issue its Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$135,000,000 in order to loan the proceeds thereof to certain System Affiliates, provided that the Bonds shall not constitute a general obligation of the Authority or the County and the County shall have no expense in connection with the Projects or the issuance of the Bonds.

Section 2. All formal actions relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of the Fiscal Court of Nelson County, and all deliberations of the Fiscal Court of Nelson County which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements. All prior resolutions of the Fiscal Court of Nelson County that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon adoption, as provided by law.
