SPECIAL REQUEST- BARDSTOWN BOURBON COMPANY/INDUSTRIAL REVENUE BONDS

A request from the Bardstown Bourbon Company was presented to the Court for approval on consolidating the names for the Company in regards to a previously approved Industrial Revenue Bond. The Court had earlier approved the two companies known as Bardstown Barrel and Bardstown Bottling. The name on the Industrial Revenue Bond will be changed to Bardstown Bourbon Company.

On motion of Keith Metcalfe, second of Jeff Lear, by unanimous vote of the court, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED to approve the request to consolidate the names for the Bardstown Bourbon Company.

ROAD DEPARTMENT

The County Bulky item pickup was completed on April 8, 2020. Several County workers were sent out to clear the roads of trees after severe weather. The next few days were also assigned to cleaning tree debris from the storm. Replaced Culverts for roads scheduled overlays. Replaced four pipes on Coon Hollow Road and now the road is ready for overlay. The department is currently replacing two pipes on Wilkerson Road in District #5. The department has graded and rocked some areas for Cecil Ridge and Leonard Hall Road in District #1. Grade work has been completed on some ditch lines (for improve drainage) in Pembroke subdivision. Dead trees have been removed on McCubbins Lane and Barnes Road in District #3. Mowing rite a ways will begin on May 4, 2020 in District #4. Mowing will be rotated in the Districts. A Purchase Order has been sent for a dumped for a Dodge 5500. The cost with the install is \$9700.00.

County Engineer Brad Spalding reported, Bids will be opened for Whiteside's road on May 5, 2020.

Paving will begin on April 27, 2020 for several roads we had scheduled for last year. This list may be completed in two to three weeks.
