The following is the Nelson County Road Department (NCRD) policy for snow removal/plowing of County Roads. County Road areas are assigned to specific trucks/personnel. The areas are or shown on the attached map. All Road Department personnel are to use their judgement and Be Safe when plowing/salting roads.

Salt Sand mixture is used for deicing County paved roads

Paved Roads: Push/plow Snow when required
Typically 2" deep or more

Chip Seal Roads: Push/plow Snow when required
Typically 2 to 2-1/2" deep or more. Very light down pressure

Gravel Roads: Push/plow Snow when required
Typically 4" deep or more.

State Roads: Plow State Roads when traveling to and from a County Road when necessary. Do not apply salt unless instructed specifically for that road or a dangerous situation exists. Contact NCRD dispatch
If the State has recently plowed and applied salt. Do Not Plow

Salt Application: Salt shall be applied on hills and curves typically and on straight stretches when necessary. Operator shall use his judgement on straight stretches.

Sand/Salt Mix: Will be used depending on the temperature/snow event.

If inclement weather is expected, all NCRD personnel will be required to report to work earlier than normal as directed or notified. All Magistrates are requested to contact Brad Spalding 502-348-1880 or 502-827-1823 or Lee Mattingly 502-331-7989 or 502-348-1880 with specific requests for snow removal when necessary.

Subject: Request for authorization and clarification of snow removal policy for Kentucky State Highway Department maintained highways in Nelson County, KY -

Question/Clarification:

1. Plowing State roads when traveling to and from another County Road. What if the State has already plowed and salted.? What if you are not sure the road has been salted.

Plowing State roads when traveling from one county road to another has been a written County policy since at least 1998. This is still the county policy. Use your judgement. Do not worry about plowing in two directions. Do not plow road if salt has been applied. If it looks like its been plowed and you can't tell if its been salted, do not worry about plowing it. Again, use your judgement. If you are not sure contact NCRD dispatch.

Note: As you are probably aware, the KYDOT splits State roads into five priorities A, B, C, D and Unassigned ("A" being the highest priority for snow removal). I have posted a map at the Nelson County Road Department (NCRD) which depicts the KYDOT Priority A, B, C & D roads for Nelson County for information.

Priority "A" roads are done the first day during a snow event.

The Priority "C" roads do not typically get plowed until the second day. For example, KY 733 is in the District 3 is a priority "C" road. These priority "C" roads are the roads typically encountered when going from one County Road to another. However, if you are on a Priority "A" road and it does not appear to have been plowed yet, plow it on your way to your designated areas. USE Your judgement. If you are not sure contact NCRD dispatch.

Question/Clarification:

2. Time constraints - Barely have enough time to plow County roads. Now if we have to plow State Roads will greatly impact ability to complete County Roads.??

We have all the time it takes to plow/remove snow on County roads! It does not have to be accomplished within one day. We will work overtime to plow roads. The goal is to plow every County road at least one time within a day however each snow event is different and will take more or less time. Going to a particular County road with the snow plow down will not take a substantial amount of more time.

Question/Clarification:

3. Damage to private property when plowing a State Road (mail boxes, driveways, or damage to county equipment.). Could be expensive?

Damage to personal property (mail boxes, driveways, etc) or county equipment will be reviewed and handled on a case by case basis. It doesn't matter if you are on a County Road, State Road, or in a private driveway (such as turning a truck around), accidents will happen. The County has insurance for major accidents (approx. \$1000 deductible). Minor accidents will be reviewed and any resulting damage will be repaired or reimbursement to affected property owners will be made.



Question/Clarification:

4. Should the State compensate the County if the County uses County resources on State Roads?

The majority of the Nelson County Road Department revenue for operations and maintenance (over 95 percent not counting asphalt overlay funds=occupational tax money) comes from the KY State Gasoline Tax. This funding source is identified as County Road Aid (CRA). All 120 Counties in Kentucky receive this CRA. A portion of the calculated CRA funds for Nelson County (approximately 30 percent) goes to the local KYDOT maintenance department for maintaining State Roads in Nelson County.

The CRA funds pays for all labor and materials (including salt) for the Nelson County Road Department to operate yearly. I do not know of a State regulation or State statute that prohibits County Road Departments from assisting the KYDOT in snow removal efforts or similar maintenance issues. CRA funds paying for both agencies comes from the same source.

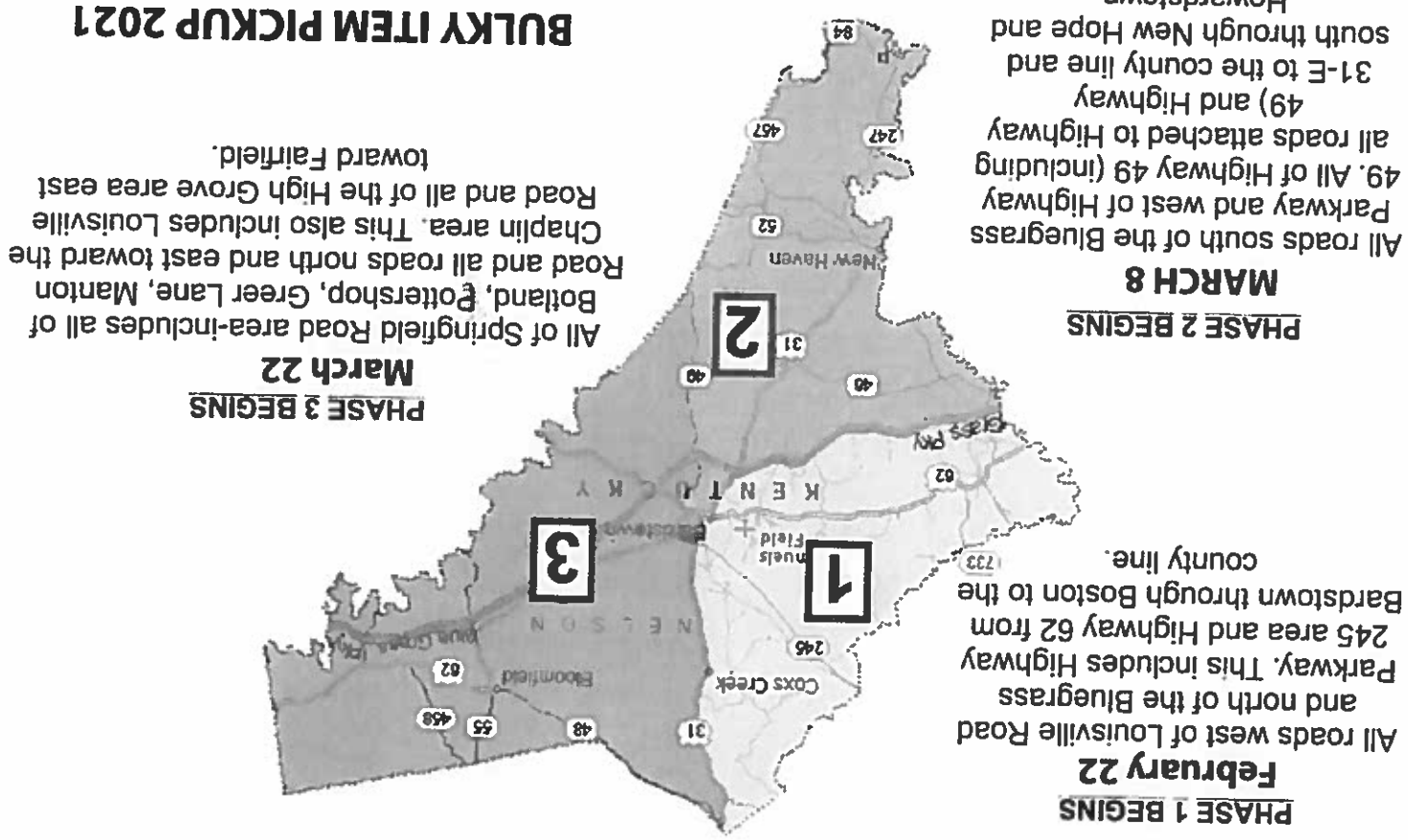
